Italy Global Immersion: Health Care in Europe: Models, Regulation, and Business

In this global immersion, students will gain insights into European healthcare models and analyze similarities and differences with U.S. models. They will explore the diverse landscape of public and private healthcare models in Europe, understand the regulatory aspects (both at the country and EU levels), and become acquainted with the business dynamics within the healthcare sector. Drawing from varied perspectives, such as government agencies, corporate businesses, healthcare providers and clinics, and/or academic institutions, students will develop a well-rounded view of different healthcare models in Europe.

This course includes two pre-departure lectures (accessible remotely), with a week-long travel component in Milan (in partnership with Bocconi University) and Bologna (in partnership with Johns Hopkins SAIS).
